## GRADES, CERTIFICATION AND INSTALLATION

### GRADES:

- SELECT - knots up to 20mm, no sapwood
- NATURAL - knots up to 40mm, sapwood allowed
- RUSTIC - knots larger than 40mm, sapwood allowed
- MIX – boards or herringbone pieces are a mix of two grades (Natural/Rustic, Select/Natural, etc...)

### INSTALLATION:
