

## ***Care and maintenance for seamless flooring***

### **Initial clean**

To ensure that your new resin floor remains in the best possible condition, and gives you years of satisfaction, the right cleaning and maintenance schedule should be followed. When first installed and fully cured, your floor should be cleaned with the correct floor cleaner, using the most appropriate equipment for the area concerned.

The method and equipment appropriate for cleaning an area will depend on its size and on the manpower available. In normal residential situations cleaning with a mop and bucket is usually the best option. Before the initial clean of your new floor the area should be swept to remove any loose debris. An inspection should then be undertaken to see if there are any stains or marks that require individual treatment.

### **Spot cleaning**

To remove marks or stains in affected areas, apply '*Oil & Grease Remover*', either as supplied or diluted with water. Leave for 5 to 10 minutes and then rub off. The floor area should then be cleaned using '*Stripping Cleaner*'. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions and test any cleaning products first on a small or hidden floor area.

### **Spillages**

Spillages of any liquid should be wiped up as soon as possible. This will help prevent the spill from soaking in and damaging the top layer of your floor. Once the spillage is removed the area should be cleaned as usual with your standard floor cleaner.

### **Pre-use inspection and precautions**

Prior to use, the floor should be inspected to ensure that it has been cleaned to your required standard and that all soiling has been removed. If you will be placing furniture, filing cabinets, etc., on the floor, then every effort should be taken to minimise surface scratching and marking. The dragging of heavy articles across the floor may cause surface damage. Take care to avoid damage from chair legs, table legs, and furniture on castors. We recommend that all items in contact with the floor should have felt pads. Castors should sit in castor cups to distribute the weight more evenly. Any chairs or other movable furniture on castors should have protective mats placed under them.

### **Looking after your floor**

We recommend the use of '*Hard Floor Cleaner*' which is a neutral floor detergent.

## **Re-surfacing the floor**

We can arrange for a deep clean of the floor surface using professional cleaning machines. It is also possible to have the surface of the resin professionally buffed and re-lacquered. Normally, this will only be needed every one or two years, depending on the use of the floor. This process will, in effect, completely renew the surface of the floor. To make this work possible, the floor will need to be entirely free of furniture and will be out of use for 24 hours.
